

- Are you reliable?

 All learners look forward to their lessons, so once their booked in always keep the appointment. Pupils hate interruption to the learning stream, don't cancel or rearrange unless it's an emergency.

Will you give full value to your pupils?

Lessons are two hours duration. That's what pupils pay for so that's what they must get. Ensure an on time start and deliver a full 120 minutes, no interruptions, no personal errands, no taking of calls in the lesson and no picking up and dropping off of family or friends.

- Are you a good rapport builder?
 Pupils who get on with their instructors stay the course and will not have their heads turned by special offers from other driving schools, they've got to know you and enjoy your company.
- Will you teach well and be professional?

What will you earn?

As you will be aware insurance costs can vary depending on a number of different factors. The prices shown for insurance are taken on a national average basis. The figures provided represent an example of franchise and car costs, which are correct at time of going to print.

IF YOU CHOOSE a brand new car rather than one of our excellent and great value nearly new options then expect a small increase to the franchise and car fee shown. This will not generally be a large additional cost and a quote can be provided on request. However do bear in mind that any quote given at the start of your training may vary (up or down!) by the time you are ready to launch in a few months time. There can also be a small additional insurance cost depending on your choice of car.

As a loyalty bonus, your Franchise Fees go down by another £10 per week year on year, right through to Year 6 – while the level of support and UNLIMITED pupil sourcing commitment remains. It's just our way of saying "thanks for being a part of the team!

Location, location

Please note that £35 is the average cost of a driving lesson, this may differ depending on where you are located (sometimes more, sometimes less).

As you become a more well-established, sought after driving instructor and your skill-set improves you will be able to demand a higher rate.

Inflation

Driving lessons are not immune to inflation, the average cost of a driving lesson increases on average £1 per hour (based on the industry average over past 10 years).

The career launch

In the run up to your last exam we'll need to start making plans for your launch. There's no need to wait until the last minute, and a bit of forward planning will ensure you get off to a flying start. This is where the Trainee licence option may come into it's own. Basically this is your chance to start working and earning before you fully qualify. It's a great shortcut if you are not working whilst training with us. But even more importantly it's a chance to do the job for real before you tackle that last exam. A no brainer for many new team members, just get exams one and two out of the way then go straight to career launch.

Alternatively, if you are still in employment at this stage we'll need to take into account any notice period you might have. There's no point us getting you fully booked with pupils when you still have two weeks to work in your present job, so let's do a proper launch that works best for you. The ideal is to have a full diary booked and ready at the end of your notice period, so you step straight out of one job and into your new one.

First thing we will need is your car choice. The team will let you know what's available in good time so you can check out the various models and choose the one that's right for you. There will be a choice of new or nearly new cars and 5 door models can be sourced if needed. Remember the car is available to you for private miles so pick one that suits your needs.

Then we need a diary plan. It's up to you how many hours per week you work, and when those hours are. But we need to know in advance so we can get your chosen diary onto our booking system and get the bookings flowing in good time.

And that's it! You can now just concentrate on nailing your last ADI exam knowing everything is prepared and your new career is finally just around the corner.
